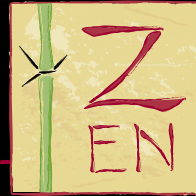

Supply Lists

Pastel Your Pet

Pastel Paper

- Pad of white or multi-colored pastel paper
- 9 x 12 or really any size you'd like

Pastels

- Soft pastels
- Multi-color pack, small pack is fine.
- (Not oil pastels)

Reference Photo

- photo of your favorite pet or animal
- optional: It would be helpful to have an additional copy of your picture photo copied and scaled to size (black/white, nothing fancy, actual pet size around 7 x 9 or less for 9 x 12 paper).

Tracing Paper

- Tracing paper pad or roll.
- 9 x 12 or similar is fine.

Other Items

- X-ACTO knife
small, artist's style is better than box-cutter type.
- Q-tips
3-5 is fine.
- Towel or rag to clean your hands while working. There is a sink and paper towels in the classroom, but you might prefer a soft rag or hand towel from home.
- Basic Supply Kit*

*Basic Supply Kit

Paper

- Several sheets of plain or scratch paper.

Pencil

- 3H or 5H drawing pencil, regular pencil, or mechanical pencil.
- pencil sharpener if needed

Eraser

- Kneaded eraser (sometimes called kneaded rubber [the grey stuff])
- or any eraser that doesn't leave smudges.

Killer Ink & Watercolor

Watercolor Paper

- 9 x 12 or thereabouts
- Cold press watercolor block (pad of sheets glued together at edges almost all the way around)
- Or single paper and a board to adhere it to with artists' or painters' tape

Watercolors

- Professional or student grade paints in these colors:
 - cadmium yellow pale hue
 - cerulean blue
 - cobalt blue
 - cadmium red
 - grumbacher red (or orange-red)
 - zinc white
 - optional: black
- Student grade pre-packaged sets of many colors is acceptable, even if these particular colors aren't included

Brushes

- Sable brushes or others specified for watercolor use in these sizes:
 - 9 or 12 round
 - 6, 8, or 10 round
 - 1 round
 - 1" or 3/4" wash (flat)
 - 4, 6, 8, or 10 flat shader
- Pack of assorted brushes is acceptable, even if exact sizes and shapes aren't present

Palette

- Paint palette suitable for watercolors, such as...
- Muffin tins or paper plates are also acceptable

Ink Pens

- Fine art ink pens—multi-size pack includes various tip sizes (ZIG, Pigma, Prismacolor or other brands)
- Single pen is acceptable, 03 or 05 size
- Optional: Fine art ink pens pack of multiple colors and/or sizes

Tracing Paper

- Tracing paper pad or roll.
- 9 x 12 or similar is fine.

Other Items

- 2 cups or glasses, plastic cups are fine.
- Tape, if using single paper and board option.
1/2" or wider artists' or painters' tape. Not other types such as masking or scotch tape.
- Paper towels or rag. Bring your own paper towels or rag to blot the brushes on, or there are paper towels in the classroom.

Fine Art Greeting Cards

Cards

- Strathmore pre-cut and folded card packs with cards and envelopes. Choose Parchment, Drawing, or Watercolor. (Or other brand.)
- Cardstock that you will cut and fold yourself is acceptable
- Optional: Drawing or watercolor paper is acceptable if you wish to color copy the final design onto cardstock to make several cards of the same design. We'll discuss this more in class.

Ink Pens

- Fine art ink pens—multi-size pack includes various tip sizes (ZIG, Pigma, Prismacolor or other brands)
- Single pen is acceptable, 03 or 05 size
- Optional: Fine art ink pens pack of multiple colors and/or sizes

Tracing Paper

- Tracing paper pad or roll.
- 9 x 12 or similar is fine.

Color Medium

- Colored pencils or fine tip markers.
Variety of colors (these are not suitable for years of display, but may last well archived in a memory book. Acid free is best.)
- Optional: Watercolor
For a long-lasting display option, choose watercolors. Use supplies from the following sections of the "Killer Ink & Watercolor" class:
 - Watercolors
 - Brushes
 - Palette
 - Plus 2 cups or glasses, plastic cups are fine.
 - Paper towels or rag. Bring your own paper towels or rag to blot the brushes on, or there are paper towels in the classroom.

Other Items

- Basic Supply Kit*
